

William Jones - Born c 1777.

He was a blacksmith and owned a farm house about a 1/2 mile up toward Goppafach. The name of the farm was Llynllwsthor. He died in 1832 & was buried in Tan Eglwys, Llandudfach.

His brother & sister consisted of John - Thomas Ann. Daniel - Sarah - William - Samuel & Morgan.

His brother Samuel was in the British Army.

He was 6' 2" tall and was through the battle of Waterloo and was sent to St. Helena as a guard for Napoleon Bonaparte. He had from exposure in Madras East India.

William Jones (1777) was first married to Sarah Thomas daughter of Benj. Thomas & she died in 1810. His second marriage was to Ann Thomas daughter of David Thomas of Parryglham or Gledin. ^{CARDOR} He was the Estate of the Earl of ~~Cardor~~. William Jones lived

over 30 years in the house near the bridge near Douglas. Here all his children were born.
